Day 01 -27 January

Depart Boulder City by bus for the Los Angeles Airport and our Singapore Airline flight to Singapore.

Day 02 – 28 January

Lose this day as we cross the International Date Line.

Days 3 & 4 29 & 30 January

Two nights in Singapore, hotel, transfers and lots of Singapore Airline specials included.

Day 5 – 31 January : ARRIVE IN HANOI (-/-/D)

Arrival at Noi Bai airport in Hanoi. Transfer to hotel for check-in. Dinner and O/N in Hanoi.

Day 6 - 01 Feb 08: HANOI (B/L/-)

Whole day city tour including Ho Chi Minh Complex with Ho Chi Minh's Mausoleum, Ho Chi Minh's House and One-Pillar Pagoda then visit the museum of ethnology with the presentation of over 50 hilltribe groups of Vietnam, the unique one in Vietnam. Lunch then visit the Temple of Literature and Hanoi Hilton prison. Enjoy the Water Puppet Show before return to your hotel. Evening free and O/N in Hanoi

Day 7 - 02 Feb 08: HANOI - HALONG (B/L/D)

Morning depart from Hanoi to Halong. It will take you 3 hours driving and you can stopover en route to sightsee the Red River delta with ploughing buffaloes, peasants scooping water or harvesting on the paddy fields, as well as visit factories producing embroidered, stone-carving or ceramic products. Arrive Halong at noon time, your private wooden boat is waiting for you at the Wharf of Halong. Take your boat to cruise the bay to visit spectacular seascape of Halong with odd-shaped islands, numerous limestone grottoes, or for swimming at sandy beaches on the islands. A lunch of fresh seafood will be served on board. Enjoy sceneries on the bay and pass the most beautiful areas of the bay like seadog rock, Fighting Cock Islet, Thien Cung (Heaven palace) cave or stop for swimming. Back to Halong and Overnight in Halong

Day 8 - 03 Feb 08: HALONG - HANOI - HUE (B/L/D)

Before our mid-morning return to Hanoi, you will have time to explore Halong market which is a 2 block walk from the hotel. When we arrive in Hanoi we will have enough time for the highlight of the day will be a cyclo tour around Hoan Kiem Lake and the famous Old Quarter of Hanoi. After an early dinner, we will take the night train to Hue 19.00 - 08.00. Overnight on the train

Day 9 - 04 Feb 08: HUE (B/L/-)

Welcome at Railway Station for the tour. Start to visit the Royal Citadel, the Forbidden City and Hue Royal Museum. This area abounds with history and traces of the last Vietnam feudal dynasty. Check-in the hotel and lunch at local restaurant. In the afternoon, visit Thai Hoa Palace, Ngo Mon Gate, Nine Dynastic urns- Imperial Citadel. We will spend overnight in Hue.

Day 10 - 05 Feb 08: HUE - DA NANG - HOI AN (B/L/-)

Our morning will start with a charming half day boat trip on the Perfume River. There is constant activity on the river with boats hauling sand, fruit and other items. You will feel "up close and personal" with the local people of Hue. The trip will also include stops at Thien Mu Pagoda and Tu Duc Tomb. After lunch we will board the bus to the resort city of Hoi An. The drive will take us via Danang city, the Cloudy Pass (Hai Van Pass) with panorama views of the countryside, Lang Co beach and stopovers to see the Marble Mountain and Cham Museum. Upon arrival in Ho An, we will check-in to our resort hotel.

Day 11 - 06 Feb 08: HOI AN - MY SON - HOI AN (B/L/-)

A morning departure will take us to visit My Son Holy Land, the most concentrative and impressive combination of Cham Towers. Here you will learn about the Cham culture that grew and developed in the location of present Central Vietnam. (Note: There is considerable walking on this tour, but seeing the century-old structures is worth the effort.) Hoi An is a very easy city to explore and the hotel is located within easy walking distance of the quaint city center. In the afternoon, you may want to walk over the tile-roofed Japanese Bridge, visit taciturn Chinese Assembly Halls and Trading Houses, pagodas or stroll into local the market. A visit to the market is a must to see the enormous variety of products available to purchase. Hoi An is THE PLACE to have silk dresses, shirts, suits, etc. made. It would be a good idea to do your shopping this afternoon so that clothes can be made and fitted on our free day. Overnight in Hoian.

Day 12 - 07 Feb 08: HOI AN (B/-/-)

Today is a free day. Cycling is one of the best way to visit this town. Bicycles are available to rent for \$1-\$2 per day right across the street from the resort. The riding is very easy because the area is so flat. You might want to take a taxi to the beautiful sandy Cua Dai (Big Beach) about 3-miles from the resort. Another option is to rent a boat to take a river tour of the area. Or you may just want to relax and soak up some sun by the resort swimming pool....the day is yours!
Overnight in Hoian.

Day 13 - 08 Feb 08: HOIAN- DANANG - SAIGON (B/L/-)

We will drive to Danang after breakfast to take a morning flight to Saigon. After hotel check-in and lunch, we will enjoy a half day orientation tour of the city including the Notre Dame Cathedral, Central Post Office and visits to the Reunification Palace, Binh Tay market and Vinh Nghiem pagoda. Overnight in Saigon.

Day 14 - 09 Feb 08: SAIGON – CU CHI TUNNELS (B/L/-)

Whole-day excursion to Tayninh Holysee to visit a special temple of Caodaism, a local sect of Buddhism. Join the Middy Ceremony at the Holysee before carrying on to sightsee Cu Chi tunnel, an amazing underground system made by the Vietnamese villagers to survive the Vietnam War. You will have the opportunity to climb through the tunnels. It is a very moving experience for those of us who knew people who were in Vietnam during the war. O/N Saigon.

Day 15 - 10 Feb 08: Saigon - My Tho - Ben Tre - Can Tho (B/L/--)

7:30 AM Pick up at hotel in Saigon. Depart for My Tho. Take the boat ride through the Bao Dinh natural canal, view the stilt houses and the fruit plantation along the river sides. Visit the My Tho wholesale fruit market. Proceed to the Tortoise island. Lunch served in the heart of the orchard. Enjoy the nice boat ride through the Tan Thach natural canal in Ben Tre, cruise under the shadow of the water coconut trees. Visit the family where you can experience the agricultural lifestyle. Trekking through the fruit plantation in Thoi Son island, enjoy the rowing boat ride along the creeks before returning to My Tho by motorised boat. Proceed to Can Tho via Vinh Long. Check in on arriving. Dinner on guests account. Overnight Can Tho.

Day 16 - 11 Feb 08: Can Tho - Xeo Quit - Long Xuyen - Chau Doc (B/L/--)

After breakfast. Visitors first take the boat trip to explore the picturesque tributaries of the Lower Mekong river (the Bassac river) .

The boat trip later takes you to the Cai Rang and Phong Dien floating markets, which are the most original ones and bustling places of the region. Visitors will have the most probably tried the Vietnamese vermicelli soup? So, they will now go and see how it is made. Visitors then roam into the village to get in touch with the local people. Here, they have a chance to experience how to pass a "Monkey bridge" which is built by only one bamboo. Stop for lunch.

Proceed to Chau Doc via Long Xuyen to visit the Thot Not bird Sanctuary. Check in on arriving in Chau Doc. Admire the landscape from the Sam Mountain summit down the Vietnamese - Cambodian border, visit the caved pagoda. Dinner arranged by yourselves.

Overnight the hotel in Chau Doc.

Day 17 - 12 Feb 08: Chau Doc - PhnomPenh (B/--/D)

After breakfast, we transfer to boat pier for departure to Phnompenh by speed boat (leave 8.00 am arrive Phnompenh ~ 13.00) Visitors then take the nice rowing boat trip through the floating village to visit the fish farm to see how the Mekong Delta people raise fish on their floating house.

Pick up and transfer to hotel. Phnompenh city tour in the afternoon for visiting Royal Palace and Victory Monument. Dinner and overnight in Phnompenh.

Day 18 - 13 Feb 08 : Phnom Penh (B/L/--)

Breakfast at hotel, Visit Watphnom the historical of the Phnompenh Capital, then you will discover to the Khmer traditional cultural at National fine-art Museum, Lunch served at local restaurant. PM: you will be shows the truth inface of the Khmer-rouge genocidal regime by visit to Toulsleng S21 and Cheuong Ek Killing fields. Dinner will be served at the phnompenh location restaurant. Dinner on your own expense & Overnight in Phnompenh.

Day 19 - 14 Feb 08: Phnom Penh - Siem Reap (B/L/--)

After breakfast, take Express boat to Siemreap/. It take you around 5 hours. Arrival Siemreap at Noon, Pick up and transfer to hotel. Lunch. Visit Takeo, Thommanon Chausay Tevoda, Ta Prohm then back to Angkor Wat and around area. Watch the Angkor Wat Sunset from the top of Phnom Bakheng mountain. Dinner on your own expense and overnight in Siemreap.

Day 20 - 15 Feb 08: Siem Reap - Angkor Thom (B/L/--/)

Get up early and view of Angkor Wat Sunrise from 5.30 then breakfast. After that, visit the Ancient Royal capital of Angkor Thom, Bayon Temple, Baphuon Temple, Leper King Terrace, Elephan Terrace, Phimeanaks. Lunch at local restaurant the visit Preah KHan, Neak Pean, Ta Son, East Mebon and Pre Rub temples. Dinner on your own expense and overnight in Siem Reap.

Day 21 - 16 Feb 08: Siem Reap (B/--/--/)

Breakfast at the hotel. Excursion to discover Banteay Srey or the Citadel of Women, was Cambodia's last major khmer temple to be re-discovered, located at 32Km from the Siem Reap. Afternoon is free

Day 22 - 17 Feb 08: Siem reap (B/--/--/)

Whole day free at your time.

17 Feb 23: Siem Reap departure (B/--/--/)

Transfer to the airport for our Singapore flights to Los Angeles. Upon arrival, our bus to Boulder City will be waiting
